The latest report by the IPCC this week says shale gas & oil extraction is playing ever greater roll in over heating the planet. We are speeding to the brink of climate catastrophe. Methane is playing a greater roll in global heating, in shale gas wells and poorly managed oil and gas extractions. The reduction of the potent gas methane is probably the main way of staving off temperature rises of 1.5 deg C, beyond which we have a lot more extreme weather and tipping points into a climate catastrophe says Durwood Zaelke lead reviewer for IPCC. He also says countries should sharply reduce their gas use and should be in a separate agreement alongside the Paris agreement to sharply reduce the use of gas. This gas infrastructure review should have this in mind, to sharply reduce our gas use and methane gas emissions.
